Eligibility – Campers must be dependent on ventilation, CPAP, or Bi-PAP for all or part of the day. Additionally, they must be able to understand and participate in camp activities, have a medical care plan that can be carried out in a camp setting, and arrange transportation to and from camp. *Learn more about the camps and camper eligibility at* <u>www.pavenetcamp.org/campers</u>.

The campground (Camp Victory) is well-equipped with accessible buildings, paved walkways, indoor plumbing (running hot/cold water), air-conditioned cabins with bunk beds and hospital beds, a medical shed, and a cafeteria that serves three delicious meals a day.
